INTRODUCTION HANDOUT

Purpose

The purpose of this clinic is to provide comprehensive, coordinated primary care services to families living within the SCPCN boundaries, who currently do not have a family physician. The primary objective is to attach patients to a family physician.

Eligibility

Patients accepted for care at the SCPCN Family Care Clinic must:

1. Live within the boundaries of SCPCN (south of Anderson Road to city limits)
2. Have no family physician
3. Have a valid Alberta Health Care number
4. Patients can be referred by other clinics or health care facilities or, self-refer by calling the clinic
