**Whether you are an experienced family physician relocating to Calgary or you are a new medical graduate, the South Calgary Primary Care Network (SCPCN) is offering an opportunity to assist you in establishing your practice through our incubator model (Family Care Clinic). The purpose of the Family Care Clinic is to provide comprehensive, coordinated primary care services to families living within the SCPCN boundaries that currently do not have a family physician. The primary objective is to attach patients to a family physician.**

**The SCPCN will provide an established clinical office setting while you build your own family practice over a 6 month period of time. At the conclusion of this arrangement, the SCPCN will assist you with the process of transitioning into a clinical space within our area.**

**Physicians joining the SCPCN Family Care Clinic will be supported by a mentor physician, professional administrative team and electronic medical records in a dynamic, inter-professional work environment. Remuneration for involvement in SCPCN programs and services is consistent with other primary care networks within the province.**

**The South Calgary Primary Care Network is located in the southernmost and fastest growing area of Calgary. The area boasts a vibrant, youthful population, easy access to cultural and recreational amenities as well as the state of the art South Calgary Health Campus, set to open in 2012.**
