- POST TRAUMATIC GROWTH
 - APPRECIATION OF LIFE
 - RELATING TO ONE ANOTHER
 - NEW POSSIBILITIES
 - PERSONAL STRENGTH
 - SPIRITUAL CHANGE
- STOCK UP ON COMPASSION THINK ABOUT WHO SOMEONE USUALLY IS AND NOT WHAT THEY SEEM TO BE AT THIS MOMENT





- EVERYONE SHOULD BE FOCUSING ON VIRTUAL CARE AS THE MAINSTAY OF CARE AT THIS TIME
- PLEASE DO NOT SIGN OUT TO DOCTOR ON CALL DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS IF YOU ARE CLOSED
- IF YOU ARE CLOSED OR HAVE REDUCED YOUR HOURS REFER TO THE CPSA EMAIL FROM THURSDAY WITH ITS BULLETIN OUTLINING YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES OF ENSURING CONTINUITY OF CARE IS MAINTAINED, SPECIFICALLY REGARDING SPECIMEN PICK-UP AND DELIVERY OF PATIENT RESULT REPORTS CURRENTLY RECEIVED VIA LABORATORY COURIER SERVICES
- MAKE SURE YOUR INFORMATION IS UP TO DATE WITH CLS FOR CRITICAL RESULT PHONE CALLS



- EVERYONE SHOULD BE FOCUSING ON VIRTUAL CARE AS THE MAINSTAY OF CARE AT THIS TIME
- REFER PATIENTS WITH COVID SX OR CONFIRMED/ PRESUMPTIVE COVID+ TO CENTRAL WELLNESS CENTER
 CLINIC FOR CARE
 - EXAMPLES OF REASONS TO REFER ARE ON THE COMMUNICATION AND REFERRAL FORM.
- IF PATIENTS HAVE **ANY RESPIRATORY TRACT SYMPTOMS** THAT ARE NEW, PLEASE HAVE THEM DO THE SELF-ASSESSMENT ONLINE WHERE THEY CAN REGISTER THEIR INFORMATION TO GET A CALL FROM PUBLIC HEALTH FOR SWABBING
- ASSUME THAT ANY RTI SYMPTOM IS COVID 10 DAYS OR SX RESOLUTION* WHICHEVER IS LONGER
 - FATIGUE CAN BE PROFOUND AND LAST A LONG TIME IT IS RESOLUTION OF THE RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS THAT
 YOU SHOULD FOCUS ON
- CLOSE CONTACTS OF A CASE MUST FOLLOW A 14 DAYS ISOLATION PERIOD DUE TO HIGHLY VARIABLE INCUBATION PERIOD
- TRY TO HELP PATIENTS STAY CALM



- PLEASE USE THE SUPPLIES PROPERLY... FAILURE TO USE PROPERLY AT BEST WASTES THIS VALUABLE RESOURCE, AND AT WORST CAN PUT YOU AT HIGHER RISK OF CONTACT
- PLEASE USE SOAP AND WATER TO CLEAN YOUR HANDS WHEN IT IS AVAILABLE WE HAVE ONLY
 RECEIVED A SMALL PORTION OF THE HAND SANITIZER ORDERS WE HAVE PLACED THIS IS A
 SYSTEM WIDE ISSUE HAND SANITIZER IS A CRITICAL PART OF DONNING AND DOFFING FULL PPE
- CONTINUOUS MASKING PROTOCOL NOW IN PLACE
- THERE IS ENOUGH PPE FOR YOUR CLINIC IF YOU ARE OPEN AND SEEING PATIENTS.

HEALTH CARE WORKER... OH NO, I'M SICK!

- ALL HEALTH CARE WORKERS SHOULD BE DOING A DAILY FITNESS TO WORK CHECK IN BEFORE THEIR SHIFT – IDEALLY BEFORE ARRIVING AT CLINIC
- IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OR HAVE A HIGH-RISK CONTACT YOU SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SELF ISOLATE AND
 - CALL THE DIRECT LINE TO HEALTH LINK FOR PHYSICIANS ONLY 587-284-5302
 - OR THE ONLINE **HEALTH CARE WORKER** SELF ASSESSMENT AT WWW.AHS.CA/COVID
- PLEASE LET US KNOW IF YOU HAVE HAD TO SELF ISOLATE SO WE CAN MONITOR THE IMPACT AND MAKE PLANS TO ASSIST YOU AND YOUR TEAM
- REMEMBER: YOU CAN STILL DO REMOTE CARE FOR YOUR PATIENTS IF STAFF STILL UP AND RUNNING (USE YOUR MEDICAL HOME FUNDING!!)
- YOU MUST NOT WORK IF YOU ARE SICK GET SWABBED AND GET DIRECTION FROM MOH

PATIENT CARE - CARE TRAFFIC CONTROL

- ANY PATIENTS WITH POSITIVE SWAB RESULT FOLLOW PATHWAY!!
- NEGATIVE SWAB PATIENTS RECEIVE AN AUTOMATED CALL FROM PUBLIC HEALTH
- ECFCC IS THE VIRTUAL "LANDING ZONE" FOR ACUTE CARE DISCHARGE, ER REDIRECT AND 811 LESS
 THAN 4 HOUR AND LESS THAN 24 HOUR DISPOSITIONS
- SCPCN WILL GET REDIRECTS FROM 811 AND ER THAT NEED TO BE SEEN URGENTLY AND CAN BE SEEN IN COMMUNITY
- SCPCN WILL GET A DAILY LIST OF PATIENTS FROM ACUTE CARE AND PUBLIC HEALTH AND CONNECT THEM BACK TO YOU
- IF WE ARE UNABLE TO DO THAT, WE WILL DO FOLLOW UP UNTIL YOU CAN (IE. WEEKEND, AFTERHOURS, ABSENCE)
- UNATTACHED PATIENTS WILL BE CARED FOR BY CENTRAL ACCESS TEAM

...SCPCN HAS A COORDINATED RESPONSE TO CARGILL...

- SCPCN HAS PARTNERED WITH AHS, PUBLIC HEALTH AND THE TOWN
 OF HIGH RIVER IN A COORDINATED RESPONSE
- 500+ PATIENTS WERE SWABBED POSITIVE FOR COVID 19; 158/500
 WERE DECANTED TO SCPCN

Liaisons will connect with affected clinics


Share and discuss available resources for patients

PRIMARY CARE COVID MANAGEMENT PATHWAY

- PLEASE REVIEW PATHWAY ON SPECIALIST LINK RECENT REFINEMENTS
 - SMOKING IS A MAJOR RISK FACTOR FOR POOR OUTCOMES.
 - ALBERTAQUITS IS A GREAT RESOURCE AND THERE HAS BEEN INCREASED FUNDING FOR NRT
 - ASTHMA DOES NOT SEEM TO BE AS MUCH OF A RISK FOR POOR OUTCOME
- REACH OUT TO COVID SPECIALIST LINK GROUP IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS/ CONCERNS WITH A SPECIFIC PATIENT
 - THEY ARE NOW WORKING SEVEN DAYS A WEEK AND EVENINGS
 - THIS TEAM CAN ACCESS COMMUNITY PARAMEDICS
 - THIS TEAM WILL ALSO DIRECT TRANSFER TO ER IF NEEDED FOR POSSIBLE ADMISSION
- IF EMERGENCY HAVE YOUR PATIENT CALL 911 AND YOU CAN CONTACT RAAPID TO HAND OFF





 - COVID POSITIVE PATIENTS FROM PUBLIC HEALTH
 - COVID POSITIVE PATIENTS FROM INPATIENT CARE WARDS.
 - RAPID FOLLOW UP BEFORE WE REPATRIATE PATIENTS TO MRP
 - REDIRECT FROM ER
 - REDIRECT FROM 811
- CONTINUITY OF CARE SOAP NOTE FAXED TO MOST RESPONSIBLE PHYSICIAN
